

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STATEMENT


22 August 1944

I, ROBERT T. RHILINGER, 0-773445, AC, was the Bombardier on the ship of 2nd Lt WILLIS H. MALAKOWSKI, 0-705742, which flew in the sixth position of the formation on 20 August 1944 with B-24 Airplane number 41-29588, piloted by 2nd Lt ELWOOD V. WILSON, 0-820130. This ship was flying in number seven position. En route to the target, the subject ship slid underneath us and to the left. It then made a direct turn and headed in the direction of our home base. All four engines seemed to be in operation at that time, although the ship appeared to be losing altitude.


